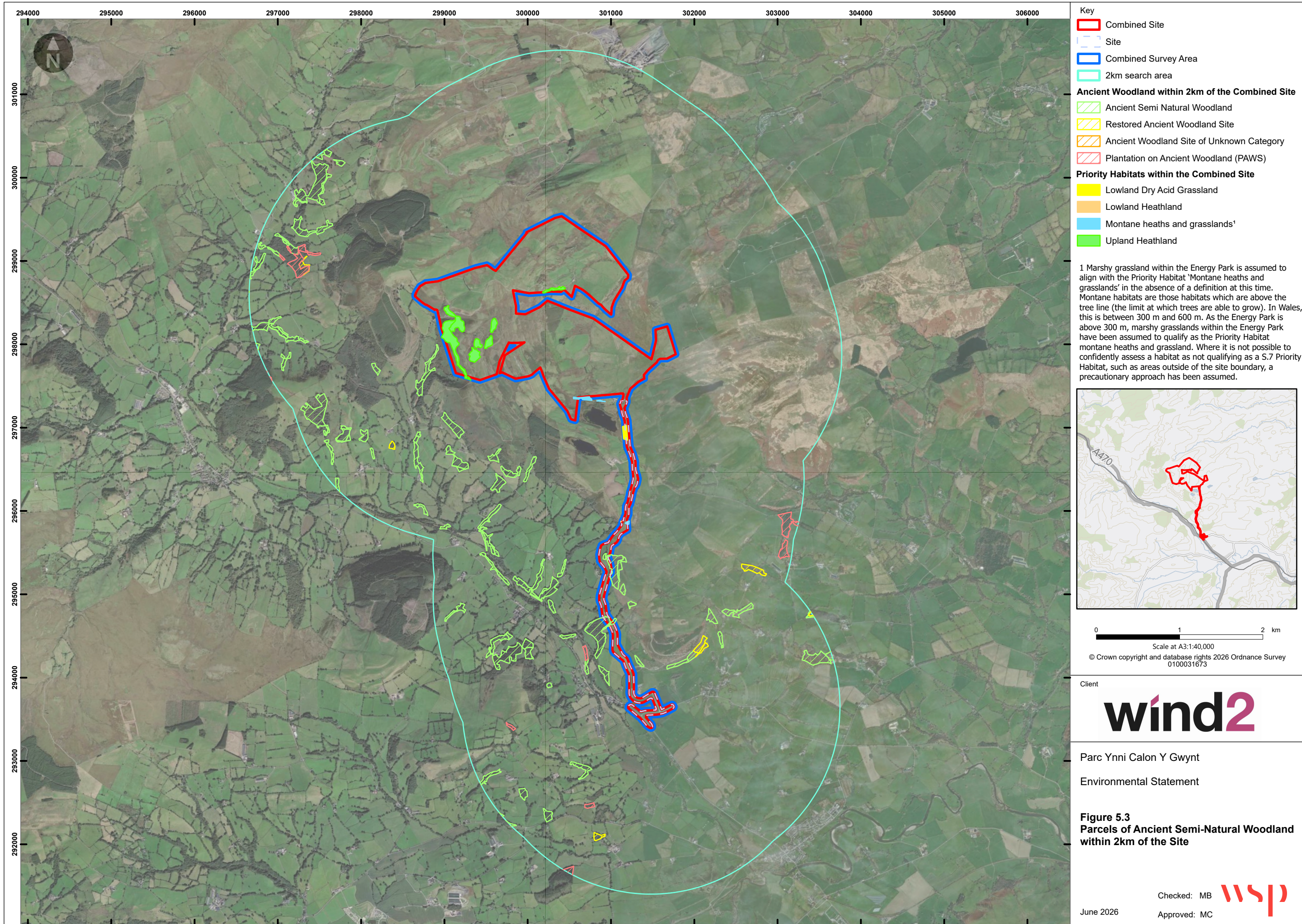
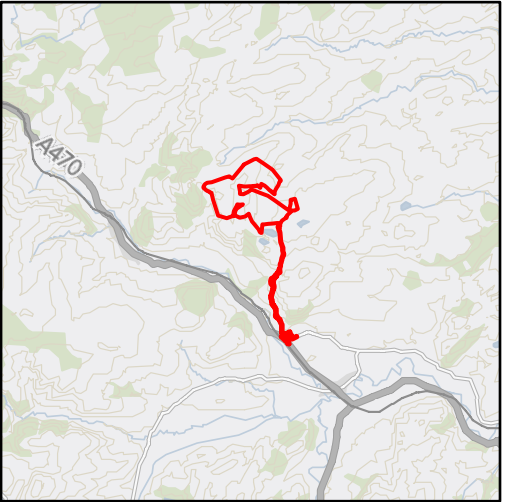

1 Marshy grassland within the Energy Park is assumed to align with the Priority Habitat 'Montane heaths and grasslands' in the absence of a definition at this time. Montane habitats are those habitats which are above the tree line (the limit at which trees are able to grow). In Wales, this is between 300 m and 600 m. As the Energy Park is above 300 m, marshy grasslands within the Energy Park have been assumed to qualify as the Priority Habitat montane heaths and grassland. Where it is not possible to confidently assess a habitat as not qualifying as a S.7 Priority Habitat, such as areas outside of the site boundary, a precautionary approach has been assumed.
